India GC8 Allocation

- For GC8, India has been allocated up to **US\$300,000,000** for HIV, TB and building resilient and sustainable systems for health (RSSH).

Eligible disease component	Allocation up to US\$	Allocation Utilization Period
HIV	100,000,000	1 April 2027 to 31 March 2030
Tuberculosis	200,000,000	1 April 2027 to 31 March 2030

- **No allocation for malaria in GC8**
- **GC 8 will be the final allocation for India for HIV**, with the expectation that HIV programmes and **GC 9 is expected to be the final allocation for TB**, after which the programmes are expected to transition fully to domestic funding.
- Grant allocation amounts have been accepted.

GC 8 Submission Windows

- The submission window deadlines and subsequent Technical Review Panel meetings for Grant Cycle 8 are listed below

Preferred Submission Pathway and Window

A meeting was convened under the Chairpersonship of AS&MD (NHM) / Member Secretary, India CCM to deliberate upon India's GC8 preparation on **2nd April 2026**, the following decision points were taken regarding the submission pathway and the preferred submission window:

- i. **Submission pathway:** It was agreed to adopt the **Grant-Ready** pathway for GC8 submission. However, in case suitability is not found with the existing PRs of GC-7, India will go in for the process of fresh PR selection.

Grant Ready pathway: shortlist and recommend 2 Nos. of NG PRs from the existing 6nos. of NGPRs of the ongoing GC-7 grant.

- ii. **Preferred submission window:** The second submission window (**27th July 2026**) was identified as the preferred timeline for submission of the GC8 funding proposal. In the event that a fresh PR selection process is required, the third submission window (**5th October 2026**) will be considered.
